### ***STUDENT PILOT POLICY LETTER***

1. Student pilots will complete the aircraft checkout test and the pre-solo written test prior to their first solo.
2. Progress Check #2 will be satisfactorily completed prior to first solo. (Flight Lesson #11)
3. Student pilots are not authorized to fly solo cross-country until completing night flying training.
4. No student will begin a solo cross-country flight if that flight will not return to TIW at least one hour prior to sunset.
5. Student pilots are not authorized to fly solo at night.
6. Students are required to file and open a flight plan for every cross-country. In addition students will make at least one position report with FSS on each solo cross-country.
7. Students will not conduct solo cross-country flights to the San Juan Islands.
8. Student pilots who will be flying a solo cross-country will schedule a minimum of 30 minutes with an instructor to ensure adequate time for the instructor to review and endorse that cross-country. Prior arrangements must be made with another instructor if your instructor is unavailable. The review may only be done on the day of the flight.
9. Students enrolled in the FAR 141 course are reminded that only authorized airports are to be used for cross-country flights.
10. All students must read and comply with the Safety Policy Letter and the Renter Policy Letter.
